RE: Hazard Communication Safety Data Sheet and Hazard Communication Standard Labels

To whom it may concern,

The Hazard Communication Standard (HCS) requirements for chemical manufacturers, distributors, or importers do not apply to Noble Company FreeStyle Linear Drain™ however, packaged with the base is NobleSealant 150. To comply with the standard, the SDS for the NobleSealant 150 is attached below with the following communication with regards to the FreeStyle Linear Drain:

Noble FreeStyle Linear Drain is considered an article under [29 CFR 1910.1200](#).

"[Article](#)" means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a [hazardous chemical](#) (as determined under [paragraph \(d\) of this section](#)), and does not pose a [physical hazard](#) or health risk to employees.

As such, Hazard Communication Safety Data Sheets and Hazard Communication Standard Labels are not required for the FreeStyle Linear Drain. The proper labels are attached to the carton if the NobleSealant 150 is included in the package.
